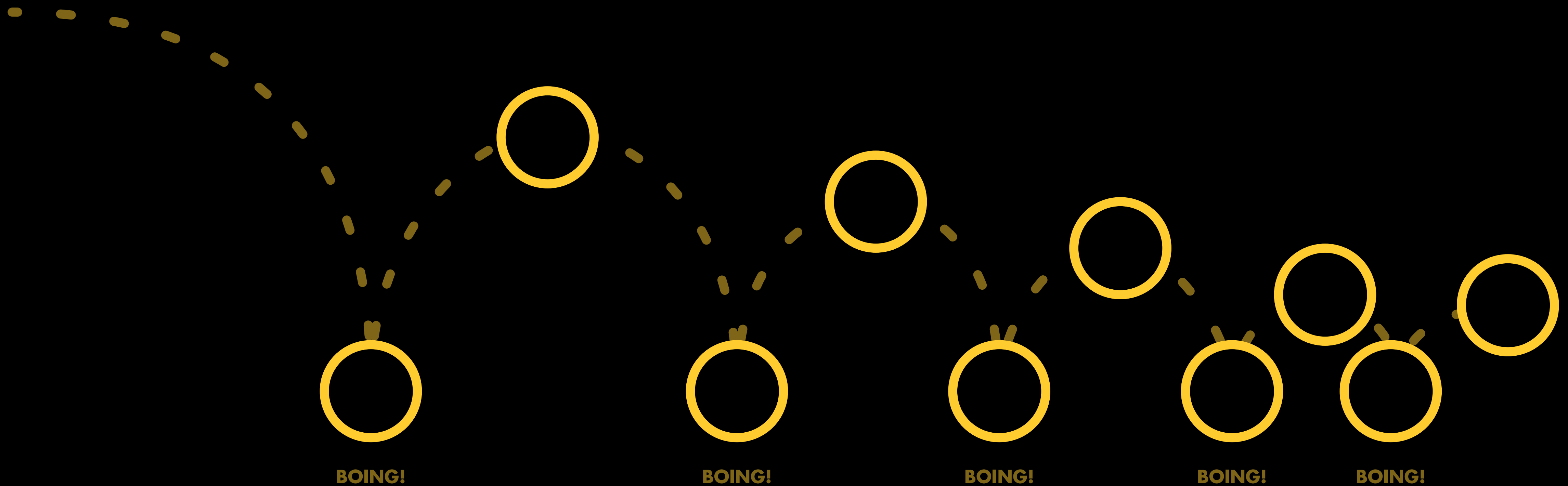


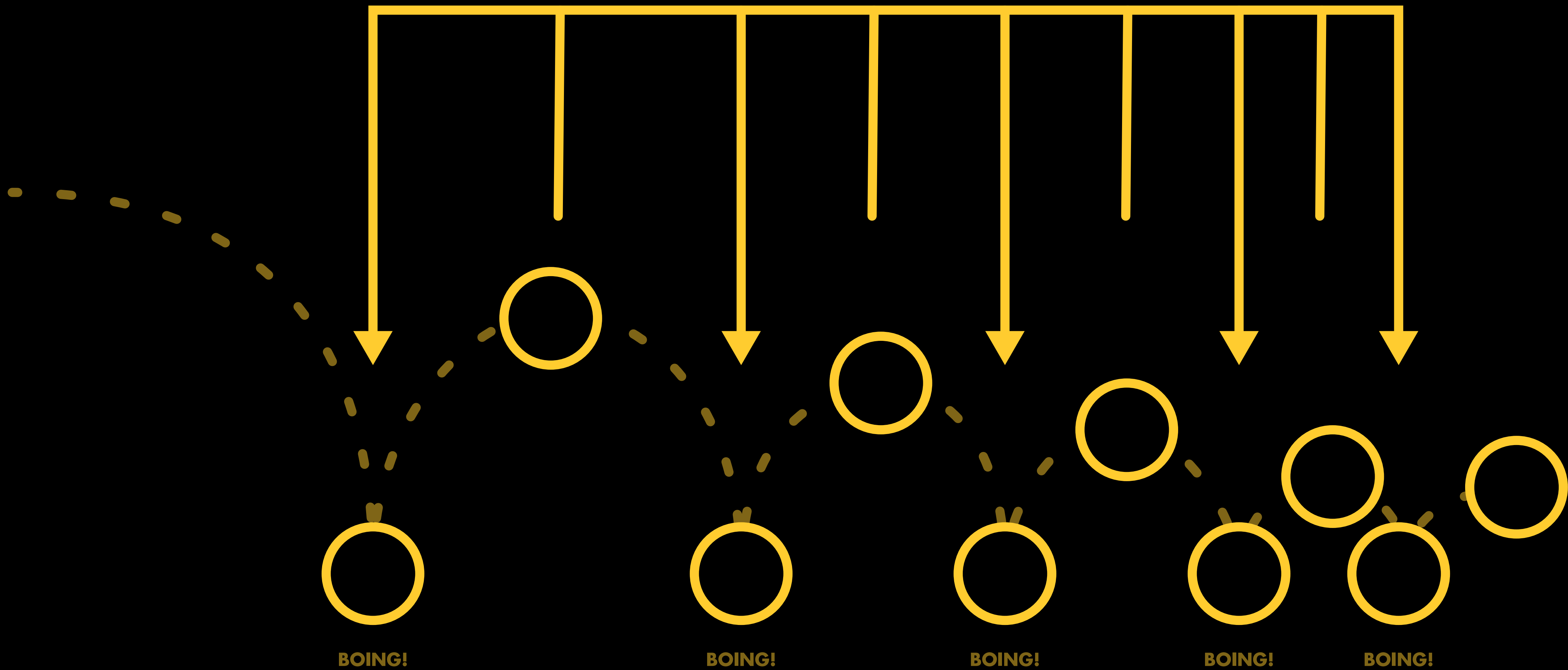
Timing and Spacing

So far, we've only looked at timing; AKA the keyframes

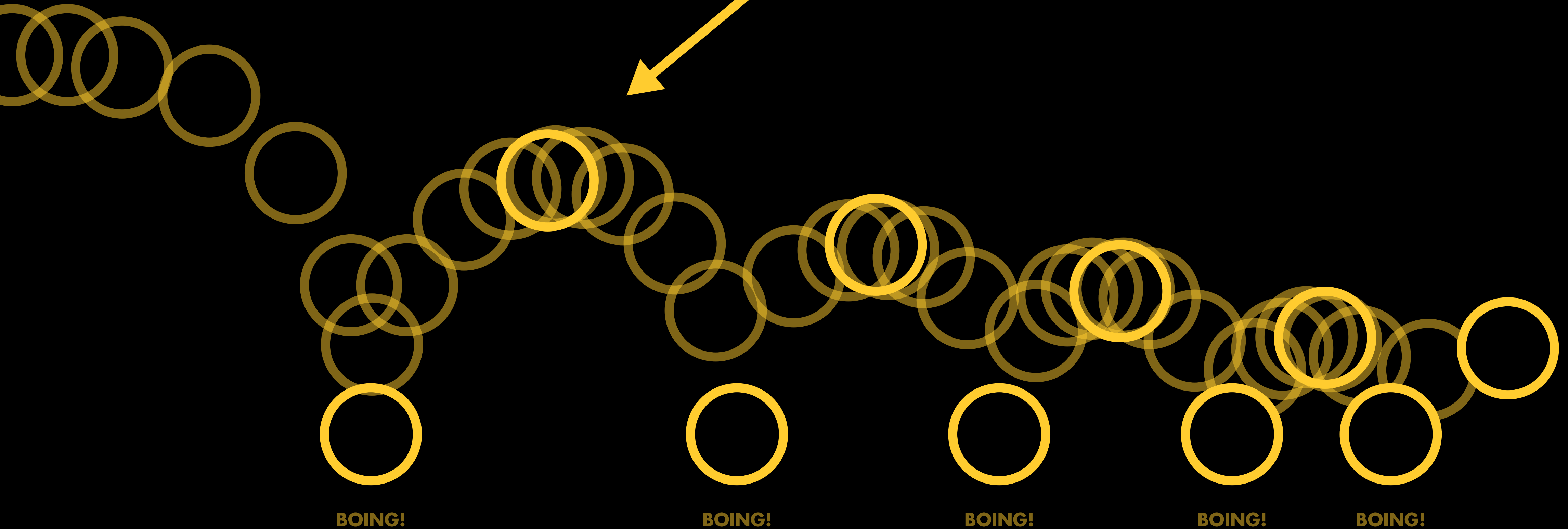
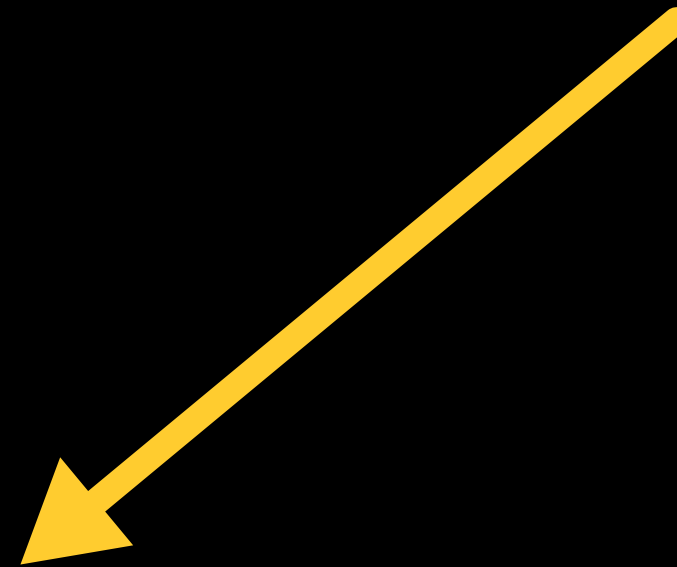

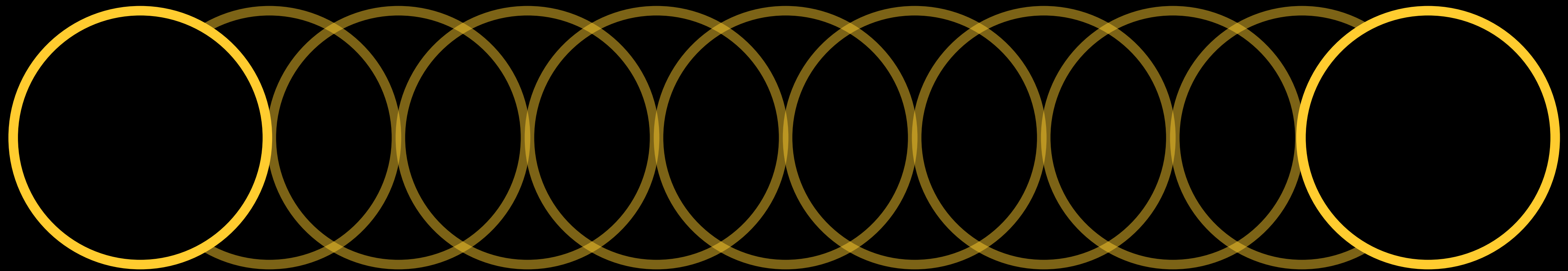
Keyframes



Spacing

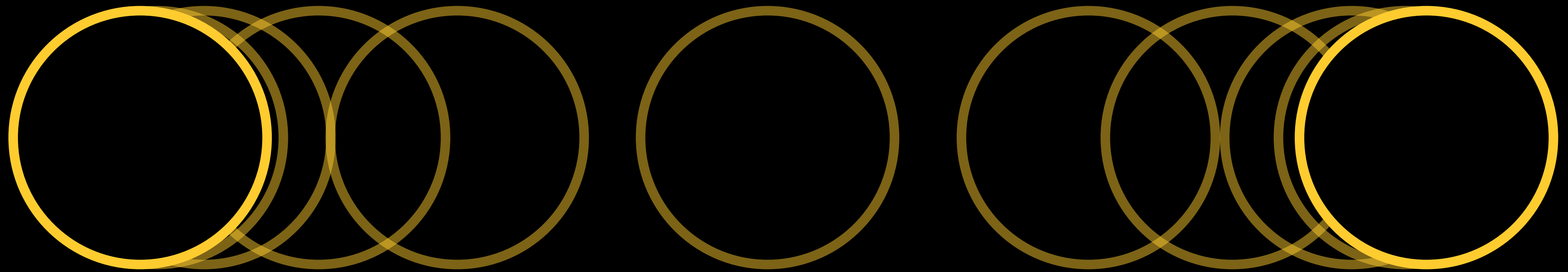


Linear Animation

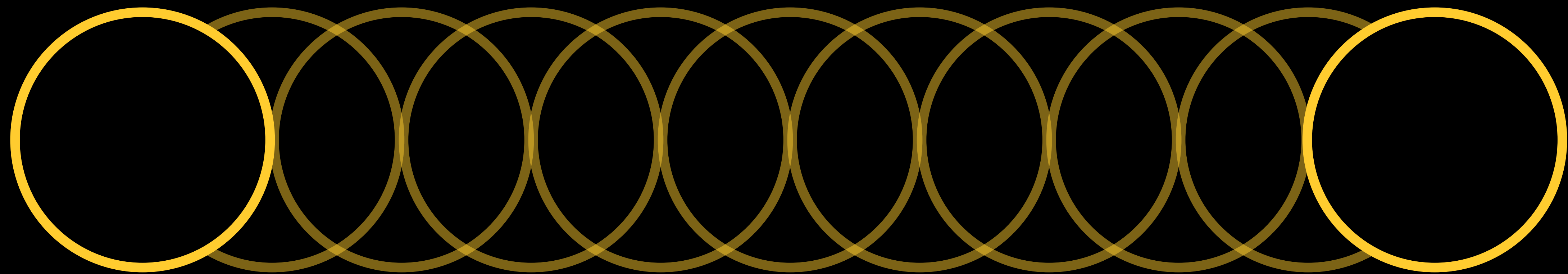


This is the default setting in After Effects.
It is often not the right choice.

Eased Animation



More energetic. Eases in and out, with a faster middle.
Still two keyframes. Still 11 frames long. But the Spacing is all new.
