

## DESN 261 - PROJECT 1 | LOGO ANIMATION

### Brief

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#### Make a classic logo move.

Because you will be hearkening to Modernist design philosophies, you will be animating in black and white **only**. Do not use grey/transparent values unless you can strongly justify your decision.

### Process

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- Pick a logo from [canadamodern.org/trademarks](http://canadamodern.org/trademarks)
  - Research the logo's history, and analyze its form for literal and conceptual meaning
  - Select a logo where you can contribute to its meaning with motion design
  - Rebuild the logo as a vector directly in After Effects, or in Illustrator. (Or comparable software)
- Precision matters!**
- Sketch ideas for how the logo can animate. Explore various directions before animating keyframes. You can sketch on paper or digitally.
  - Write and design a rationale including some context about the logo. (Who designed it? What makes it special? Why does it work?) Include your sketches to demonstrate your process and exploration.

### Deliverables

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- Export as mp4 file in the H.264 Codec
- 1080x1080px resolution
- 24 or 30 frames per second
- Rationale with included sketches
- Label files using MacEwan file naming convention

### Considerations

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- What is the narrative intention of the logo? Can you echo or reinforce that in motion?
- Are you able to add a surprising twist that only you would think of?
- Is there an element in the logo that is part of the animation, but not part of the final logo?
- Does the brand or design suggest an appropriate motion?
- The final piece will likely be very short — only a few seconds long.
